

Imlay City School Spartan Marching Band Assistant Drum Major Application

Name:

All applicants must be current band members who will be sophomores next fall and have committed to participation in band throughout their high school career.

Procedures:

- 1) Submit this application to Mr. Pries no later than 4:00 PM by April 30.
- 2) It is **strongly** recommended that all candidates make arrangements with a current drum major, or Mr. Pries, for coaching. These times may not be done during class time.
- 3) On the scheduled audition date, each candidate will audition in front of the band. The audition will consist of 4 parts:
 - 1. Short O & A
 - 2. Conducting (prepared piece)
 - 3. Marching
 - 4. Verbal Commands
- 4) All current band members present at the audition will vote for their drum major choice. The vote will determine the choice for drum major; however, the ultimate decision will be made by the Director. If for some reason the vote is tainted, or a truly incapable candidate is elected, the Director has the authority to either re-audition the candidates, or select a competent student to fill the position.

Short "Q & A" Questions:

The questions asked will be selected from the following list. You will not be expected to answer them all.

- 1) Why are you auditioning for drum major?
- 2) What are the qualities of a good leader?
- 3) What are your ambitions with the band?
- 4) As a leader, you will not make everyone happy 100% of the time. How will you reason with those who do not agree with your decisions?
- A major part of being a leader is the ability to establish a means of conflict resolution. What do you think it takes to effectively settle a disagreement?
- 6) What are your plans to better yourself as a performer?
- 7) Define "dedication" and explain why it is important for this group.
- 8) How have you made plans to stay in band until graduation?
